Dark souls item discovery ring

Alright so I did some digging using a friend, CE and the latest table(not linking it because it's Bad Stuff™). CE Values The table I used didn't list item discovery directly so I had to search a bit for it. As expected, it is affected by luck and item discovery gear. Having another player didn't change it, and having the other player equip item discovery gear didn't change it either. Now I'm not a pro at CE but I tried to find places that used the item discovery value and what I think was the drop rate formula didn't have any changes when another player equipped I.D. gear. Ingame observations First, I did 5 "cycles" of killing the 3 Silver knights in Anor Londo with no item discovery gear and noted the drops. Then I did the same with my friend, no item discovery gear. It didn't make any difference. I did 5 cycles with gold covetous ring+3, Symbol of avarice and a crystal sage rapier and noted the drops. Then I did the same with my friend (who had no I.D. gear). No difference. He then equipped the same stuff as me. 5 more cycles, no difference. We did this again a couple of times with him as a white, gold, purple and red phantom and it didn't change anything. As a last attempt, I used the Dried Fingers and summoned the max amount of players I could and got invaded. I killed the 3 knights. No noticeable difference in drops, no changes in CE. Conclusion Extra players of any kind (white, gold, purple, red), summoned or invading, do not appear to change item discovery or drop rate. One of the things that Dark Souls 3 is famous for is the various items in the games. Apart from weapons and cool spells, there are also plenty of these so-called special items which make the overall experience very cool. Having said that, the Covetous Gold Serpent Ring is definitely the most famous one of all. This ring will basically help your item discovery so that you can find more items while playing. Think of it as a potion which increases a certain stat.Wearing the actual ring increases your item discovery by 50. This makes it more likely to get different items from the enemies that you kill. It is very useful for collecting various sets for example.Let's take a look at where to find this awesome item and how to get it.Gold Serpent Ring LocationWithout the needed guidance, tracking this item could become a huge pain. As far as the information goes, the Gold Serpent Ring is located in the Irithyll Dungeon Area. The closest bonfire to that place is called profaned Capital. In order to obtain the ring, you need to enter a cell. Of course, in order to do that, you need to find the Old Cell Key first and then go inside the cell where Siegwand of Catarina is being imprisoned.In order to get the key, you need to go to the church which is located in the poison lake. Climb on the roof and you should see stairs which you need to take. They will lead you back into the dungeon but before that, you need to jump through the hole in the wall in order to get to the giant's feet. Climb the stairs and the ladder and you should end up just above the giant. After this, look around for a bridge that leads to the sewer gate. Once you find, jump on it and go all the way to the end of the tunnel in order to open the chest and get the key.After you do that, you need to go back to the cell. You can do that by going back to the toxic church and then get up on the roof and the stars. As soon as you do that, there should be a window on the adjacent building. Jump through it and then quickly climb the stars and the cell should be just in front of you. Demon's Souls fans have cracked the case of the Providential Ring. If you missed getting one, there's an alternate way to obtain the item beyond choosing it as your one-time-only starting gift. If you're way too deep in the New Game+ cycle, don't worry - you won't have to roll a new character after all.Not only is the Providential Ring inherently useful - it raises your item discovery, which is helpful for farming - it's also needed for the King of Rings trophy. Without it, you're not getting that platinum.I was fortunate enough to select it after weighing the other gifts, but if you didn't know better or you (understandably) assumed the ring could be earned another way, the community has come through.As miraculously discovered by Reddit user Hawthorne64, the Providential Ring can be earned in a not-so-simple trade with Sparkly the Crow in level 4-1. You'll need to upgrade a Scimitar (there's one in level 1-1) to a Scimitar+8 with Blacksmith Ed, turn it into a Large Sword of Searching using the Hero Demon's Soul (from the Old Hero boss), and then trade it with the crow in the Shrine of Storms.That's the deviously tricky bit: there are several ways to create the Large Sword of Searching with Blacksmith Ed, but as other players have confirmed, this trade will only work if you upgraded the Scimitar. There may be other unknown conditions, but so far, the early reports look pretty convincing. This also explains why, despite its best efforts, the community was only now able to find a solution.As someone who got all the way to New Game+2 and seriously considered starting over solely for the "all rings" trophy (long story short, I made some very bad calls in pursuit of the Friend's Ring and Foe's Ring), this is heartening news. I can sympathize with anyone who put a ton of energy into their character only to have to start anew because of one small step they messed up before beginning the game proper. Thankfully, at least in the case of the Providential Ring, there's now a backup plan.How to Obtain the Providential Ring [Reddit] It surely can't have escaped your attention by now that Dark Souls is hard - real hard - so if you're delving into Dark Souls Remastered for the first time you're going to want as much help as you can get. Experienced players will already know all the best spots to farm humanity and souls efficiently, but if you don't know your Dragon Scale from your Titanite then this is the guide for you. Not only will we explain what all of that means, but we'll also explain the best techniques and point you to some prime locations to set you on the right path. There'll be no judgement from us, just some handy Dark Souls Remastered tips to guide you through the trials ahead.Resting at a bonfire replenishes your healing flasks (known as Estus Flasks). By default, you have five of these. If you have any humanity, you can reverse your hollow status at a fire to become human. Doing so allows you to spend additional humanity to kindle a fire. Any fire that has been kindled provides ten flasks instead of five.One easy method to farm humanity is to warp to the bonfire in The Depths. The surrounding areas contain undead rats. If you have the Covetous Gold Serpent Ring equipped, the chance of a rat dropping Humanity is relatively high. Having a high humanity count (up to 10) also increases your item discovery rate. You can farm 10-15 rats in the immediate vicinity before having to return to the bonfire.You can also farm the baby skeletons in the Tomb of the Giants. They're found just before the fog door that leads to Gravelord Nito. They respawn infinitely.The absolute best method, however, is killing the numerous Giant Humanities in the Chasm of the Abyss (part of the additional content). Guess what? They drop Humanity. Sometimes Twin Humanities. And are easy to kill. And there are lots. Remember to have the Gold Serpent Ring equipped.If you're anxious to snag more souls, we found the best place to farm them. Early in the game at the Darkroot Forest, there is a door that is locked by a circular device. First, save up 20,000 souls (now's a good time to use all those soul items in your inventory). Next, visit the blacksmith in the tower leading to the Darkroot Forest and buy the crest from him. Head back to the locked door in the forest (note: there is a hidden bonfire right next to it behind a fake wall). Once unlocked, you can use following strategy to farm up over 12,000 souls in roughly 2 minutes: the ghost enemies can easily be tricked into jumping off the ledge if you bait them up the stairs. It takes a little practice, but try and position yourself so that when the ghost walks off the stairs that he'll fall directly on your head, this will bounce him off of you and into the void.Later in the game, runs from the Gwynevere's chamber down through Anor Londo with the Covetous Silver Serpent Ring equipped is a good option.If you're in human form, you can also leave your summon sign (using the White Sign Soapstone) near boss doors or pre-boss bonfires in the hopes that someone will summon you into battle. If you're victorious, you'll gain the boss's souls. Also make sure to put you sign in front of bosses that are appropriately matched to your current soul level.This is in Sen's Fortress near the control room where you can redirect the boulders. You'll want to send the boulders rolling down the winding staircase and, once a few have gone down, follow the path they take. They'll stack up in the hole at the bottom of the stairs to make a platform and smashed through the wall. Go through that hole and you'll find Covetous Gold Serpent Ring, which boosts your item discovery by 200.Where can I find the Covetous Silver Serpent Ring in Dark Souls Remastered and boost souls gainedThis is in the Giant's Tomb. After meeting your first Skeleton Beast you'll find a fog door. Through there you'll battle and archer and a Silver Knight. There's a corpse near where the archer stood, and past that a narrow path off the ledge in the image above. Fall down to it and you'll find the Covetous Silver Serpent Ring which boosts souls gained by 20%. Be careful though as several Skeleton Pillars to appear and surround you, so be ready.Where can I find the Covenants in Dark Souls Remastered?We're just giving you the areas. See those areas in our walkthrough for further details. Note that you only need to prompt the question to join and the achievement will unlock - you do not have to actually join.Way of White: Speak to Petrus in Firelink Shrine or Rhea in Undead Parish.Forest Hunter: Speak to Alvina in Darkroot Garden.Chaos Servant: Speak to Quelaag's Sister in Quelaag's Domain.Gravelord Servant: Speak to Nito (if alive) by resting in the coffin in The Catacombs.Princess's Guard: Speak to Gwynevere in Anor Londo.Path of the Dragon: Speak to the Everlasting Dragon in Ash Lake.Blade of the Darkmoon: Pray on the mat in front of Gwyndolin's fog door in Anor Londo.Darkwraith: Speak to Kaathe in the Abyss (under New Londo Ruins). If an area is listed, see that area in our walkthrough for details.Normal Titanite Slab: Stray Demon (Undead Asylum) drop (assured), Darkwraith drop (rare), Chest in Royal Wood, Sigmeyer questline reward.Red Titanite Slab: Chest in Lost Izalith, Chaos Eater drop (rare), trade for an ascended Pyromancy flame with Snuggly.Blue Titanite Slab: Chest in Crystal Cave, Crystal Butterfly drop (rare).White Titanite Slab: Chest in Tomb of Giants, Minor Pinwheel drop (rare).What's the best way to get Dragon Scales in Dark Souls Remastered?Dragon Scales are dropped by the Hyrdas in Darkroot Basin and Ash Lake. You can also find several more scales on corpses in Ash Lake. They are a rare drop from the Drakes in the Valley of the Drakes. You can also join the Path of the Dragon covenant (speak to the Everlasting Dragon in Ash Lake) and use the Dragon Eye to challenge other players for Dragon Scales.What's the best way to get Demon Titanite in Dark Souls Remastered?From Titanite Demons (aka Prowling Demons)! Unfortunately, these do not respawn with one exception: the demon guarding the shortcut bridge between the Demon Ruins and Lost Izalith. If you don't have the Chaos Servant allegiance level required to open the door (level 2), then reach this bridge from the Bed of Chaos boss door in Lost Izalith. You can also trade a Dung Pie or Prism Stone for one with Snuggly the Crow.What's the best way to get Twinkling Titanite in Dark Souls Remastered? As you play through Dark Souls, you'll either find this titanite in chests or obtain it from Crystal Lizards. Crystal Lizards tend to run away and burrow underground when you get close, but they'll only disappear permanently if you kill them. Twinkling Titanite is a rare drop from the Stone Knights in the Royal Wood. You can also buy Twinkling Titanite from the Giant Blacksmith. Finally, you can trade a Bloodred Moss Clump or Purple Moss Clump for one with Snuggly the Crow.What is Snuggly the Crow and where do I find it in Dark Souls remastered?On the side of the upward slope leading out of the undead asylum, you'll notice a small crow's nest. You can drop items inside this nest, quit your game, reload, and a new item will be in its place. You've just traded with Snuggly the Crow. Covetous Gold Serpent Ring is a special item in Dark Souls 3. It's a ring that increases your item discovery a lot, which helps you find more items while playing. Gold Serpent Ring Stats & DescriptionDescription: A gold ring depicting a snake that could have been, but never was, a dragon. Fallen foes are more likely to drop items. Snakes are known as creatures of great avarice, devouring prey even larger than themselves by swallowing them whole. If one's shackles are cause for discontent, perhaps it is time for some old-fashioned greed.Wearing the ring will increase your item discovery by 50, making it more likely to get items from enemies you kill. It's extremely useful when you want to collect item sets that certain foes use (like the Darkwraith set).
